Computer Requirement Winter 2007

Ohio University

The Interior Architecture program is excited to provide studio space, furnishings, and Internet connectivity that support opportunities with technology in facilities at Grover Center. By having a computer in the studio students will be able to more effectively learn contemporary practices and processes of design. The Interior Architecture faculty are strongly committed to provide the highest standards of design education to the students. By providing the strongest educational experience possible students can more effectively pursue career goals. Part of excellence in design education is the effective use of technology in the studio environment. The Interior Architecture faculty, Director of Human and Consumer Sciences, Dean of Health and Human Services, the Ohio University Fees Committee, and the Provost, all support and approved the computer requirement so the highest quality design education can be brought to the students. The total cost for the computer, software, scanner, digital camera, printer, and server should not exceed \$3,500.

The Interior Architecture program implemented the computer requirement effective Fall of 2001. All students in the Interior Architecture program who have progressed successfully past the portfolio review are required to have a computer in studio for all HCIA studio and related support courses effective Fall 2001.

Computer graphic applications used in Interior Architecture require large amounts of RAM memory, processing speed, and hard drive storage. Although many computers can “technically” run many of the graphic applications required for the program, being able to complete large complex projects for the next three years can require more than the typical desktop computer. The students are also required to contribute to a server that will be used to host WebPages and share files for courses and professional portfolios. The server will be dedicated exclusively for Interior Architecture students and will be maintained for use as a student and as an alumnus of the program three years post graduation. Current alumni have posted professional portfolios on the server this recourse has been essential in career development and educational success. As a final note you are asked to purchase your computer as soon as possible. **IF POSSIBLE PLEASE ORDER YOUR COMPUTER AND OTHER TECHNOLOGY ITEMS TODAY.** To ensure delivery by Tuesday, January 2, 2007 you need to place your order as soon as possible and no later than December 12, 2006. **All students are responsible for ensuring that their computer, software, and accessories have arrived at Ohio University by the first day of classes Winter Quarter 2007. We will be using the computer starting the first day of class.**

Software

All of the following software is required for Winter of 2007. Students must have the exact title and version number listed. Students must purchase the entire package to insure compatibility for instruction and file sharing, and academic licensing issues. Students will be expected to purchase other software packages, such as AutoCAD, as needed in future courses. The following is required for the winter and is included in the package to be purchased at the college bookstore:

Form-z 6.0 – is a powerful 3-D modeling application that is used professionally by interior designers, architects, industrial designers, and the film and entertainment industries. It can render photo-realistic models in Radiosity and Raytrace formats. The form-z application is made available to the students at a steep discount. A one-academic year student lease is \$95. The retail cost of the application is over \$2,400 a copy. With form-z you will receive a copy of the manuals in PDF format on the disks.

Adobe Creative Suite 2.3 – This includes Photoshop CS 2 the industry standard for photo digital editing. Illustrator CS 2 a layout application for graphic professionals. The suite also includes InDesign, GoLive CS 2, and Adobe Acrobat 8.0 Professional.

Macromedia Studio 8 – is a suite of professional graphic applications. Including Dreamweaver 8 a professional HTML or web site creation program. Students will be required to maintain web sites that contain assignments created in interior design courses. The portfolio web sites will be available to perspective employers. Flash Professional 8 – multi-media application for web based presentation of images and interactive graphics is also included in the software package.

Ohio University offers Adobe CS2.3 and Studio 8 at a near 50% savings over the typical educational discount. Students will be able to use Adobe CS2 and Studio 8 for the one time discounted price as long as they remain a student in the Interior Architecture program.

Future Software Obligations

During future studio courses students will be required to purchase new software titles. In the fall of 2007 students will be required to purchase AutoCAD. The current price for a one year license is \$150. Students will also be required to purchase a copy of Window XP Pro to run Autocad. Windows XP Pro can be purchased at the University for \$70 and used be run on the Intel based iMac computer.

Form-z must be renewed every academic year in the fall. The price per year is currently \$95.

Server Fee

As stated in the introduction all students are required to pay a fee for a dedicated server for their Interior Architecture classes. This server will only used by Interior Architecture students. This is an essential piece of equipment for file sharing, document backup, and creation of course and professional WebPages. Students will be able to access the server for professional portfolio use up to 3 years post graduation from the Interior Architecture program.

Insurance

Make sure that all of your equipment that you purchase is covered by insurance. Although studios are secured with key code entry and computers can be locked to the desk, equipment can still be stolen. Check existing homeowner policies to see if they cover computers or purchase renters insurance that will cover your equipment if you currently do not have a policy. Do not assume a new computer purchase is automatically covered under a current policy, high price items such as computers often require a separate listing under an existing policy. You are strongly encouraged to check with your insurance agent for further details.

Financing:

Student financial aid may be able to provide loans to qualified students for the purchase of a computer that is required for the Interior Architecture program. Contact financial aid for more information at 740-593-4141.

You may wish to investigate student loans through computer manufactures. Some computer companies offer students loans where payments are deferred until after graduation. Many local banks may offer computer loans at reasonable rates. Always compare all terms of any loan. Some loans with deferred payments allow interest to build that you are responsible for at a later date. It often pays to take the time to shop for the best financing for your financial situation.

NOTE: All students are responsible for ensuring that the computer, related equipment, and software are available for use the first day of classes. Track your orders and check on shipping status often!

3. Upon their termination, JS E Licenses will not be extended. Continuing students and instructors will be able to purchase a new License for the next academic year.

4. The JS E License is to be **used exclusively for educational purposes** and no commercial work will be allowed.

5. The JS E License **does not include technical support** by auto-des-sys and **no updates** to newer versions.

6. If a JS E License key is lost or stolen, the JS E License will be terminated. In such a case, if the holder of the lost/stolen key is not at fault, **auto-des-sys** may agree to issue another License at the regular cost.

7. **form-Z** is owned exclusively by **auto-des-sys** and is protected by the USA and international Copyright laws and Trade provisions to their full extent. **auto-des-sys** grants you a non-exclusive license to maintain a copy of **form-Z** on the hard disk of a single computer for the duration of the JS E License period. You are not allowed to disassemble, reverse-engineer, de-compile or apply any method which may expose the source code. You may not modify the software or its copy protection device, which is an integral part of the software. You may not rent, lease, or sublicense any part of the software.
